The Star of Bethlehem is an important element in the visit of the wise men to the Christ child. But what was it? Three possible explanations have been made. 1) A divine act of God; 2) an unusual astronomical event; or 3) a literary device by the author of Matthew to place emphasis on the importance of this event. Noted astronomer, Karlis Kaufmanis, starting with the Bible story of the star. searched the star maps for the Middle East at the time that Christ was born for any astronomical events that would fit with the scriptural story. Kaufmanis shared his lecture on this topic thousands of times. This presentation utilizes the Biblical story, the lecture of Kaufmanis, and documented historical facts to tell the story of the Star of Bethlehem. This program offers ideas to ponder, but the actual story remains for you to interpret as you believe it to be.
